

MINISTRY UPDATES

Friends,

As you know, with the recent emergence of the Delta Variant, COVID levels across our community have risen considerably. As a result, we find ourselves in a position of needing to adjust our COVID protocols to address the present concerns. As we have said before, our desire is to protect our ability to gather together for worship while also doing what we can to protect those most vulnerable to infection.

Beginning Sunday, August 8, we are updating our protocols in the following manner:

- 1. We are encouraging, but not requiring, all people to wear masks in worship, particularly those who are unvaccinated. 2. We are requiring that all children 11 and under, presently ineligible for the vaccine, wear
- masks in worship and in their Sunday School classes (ages 0-3 exempt). 3. We are setting aside the balcony in the Sanctuary and a designated section in Grand Hall
- for those who prefer to wear a mask and to practice social distancing. 4. All volunteers serving in our Children's ministry will be required to wear masks.
- 5. All students (12 and older) and volunteers in our Middle School and High School ministries

At this point, these are the only changes that we are putting into place. Adult Sunday School classes will still meet and the campus will remain open as before. We will continue to evaluate the situation and pray that this latest development will pass quickly.


